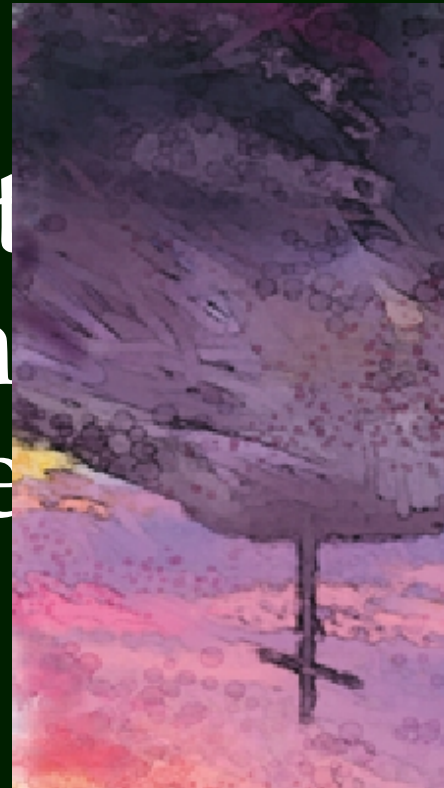


# The Blood

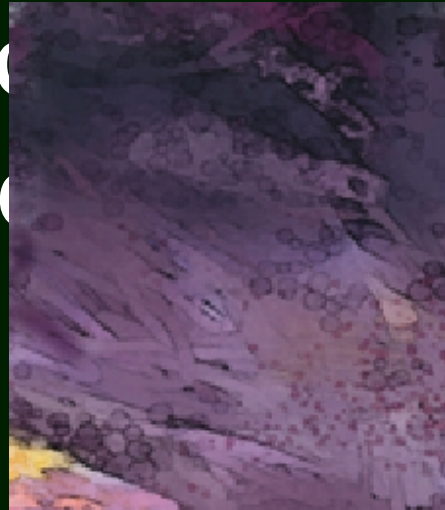

do;



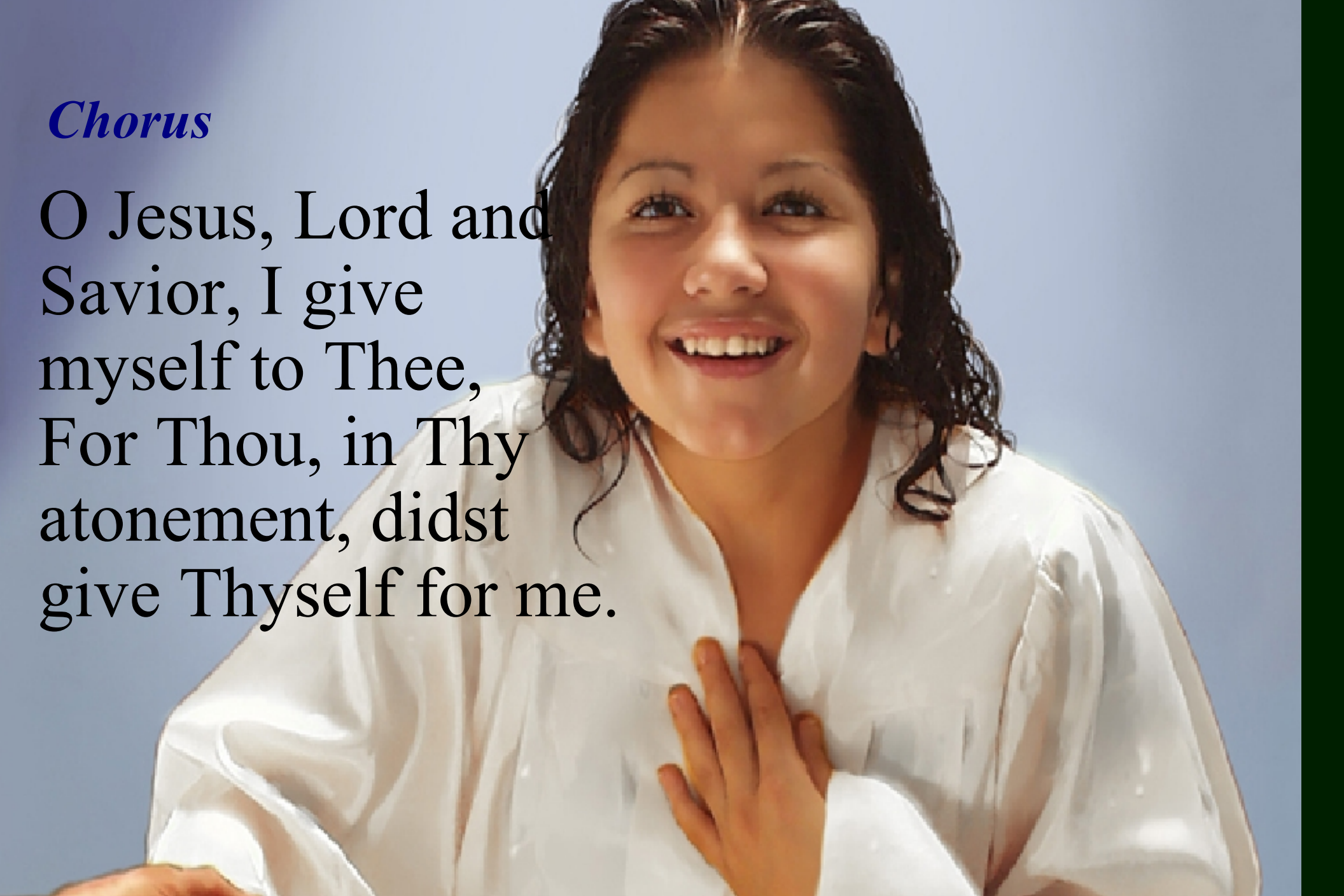


Yielding

Him my all.

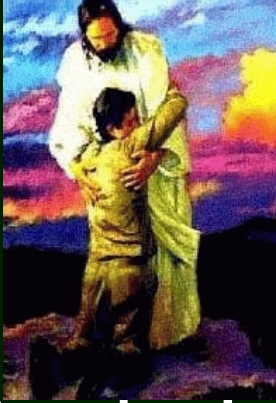

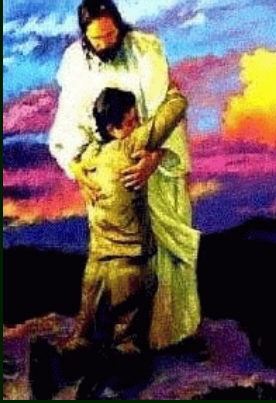


Heaven came

my soul!**

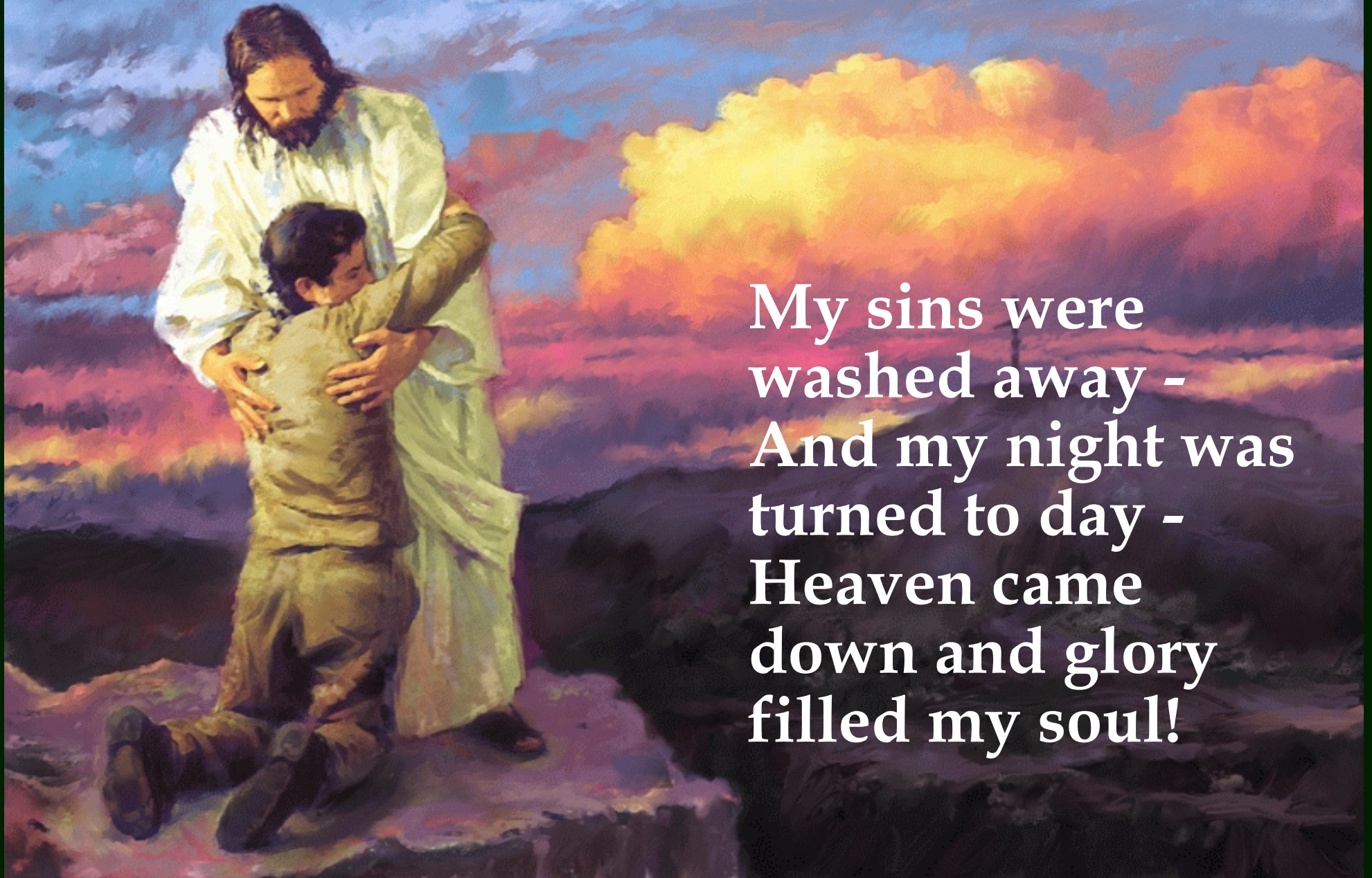


Now I've a hope that will

# Revival, Deformation, Reformation

---

- **Revival** is renewed thinking
- **Deformation** is static thinking
- **Reformation** is intrinsic behavioral change
- **Deformation** is extrinsic behavioral change
- **Revival** is a desire to do what is right
- **Reformation** is doing what is right according to the Holy Spirit
- **Deformation** is doing what is right according to tradition/people

# Revival, Deformation, Reformation

---

- **Revival** is a spirit-filled relationship with Jesus
- **Reformation** is a genuine relationship with others because of the relationship with Jesus
- **Deformation** is selective relationship with others due to a critical, self-righteous attitude
- **Revival** is Jesus **in** me
- **Reformation** is when others can **see** Jesus in me

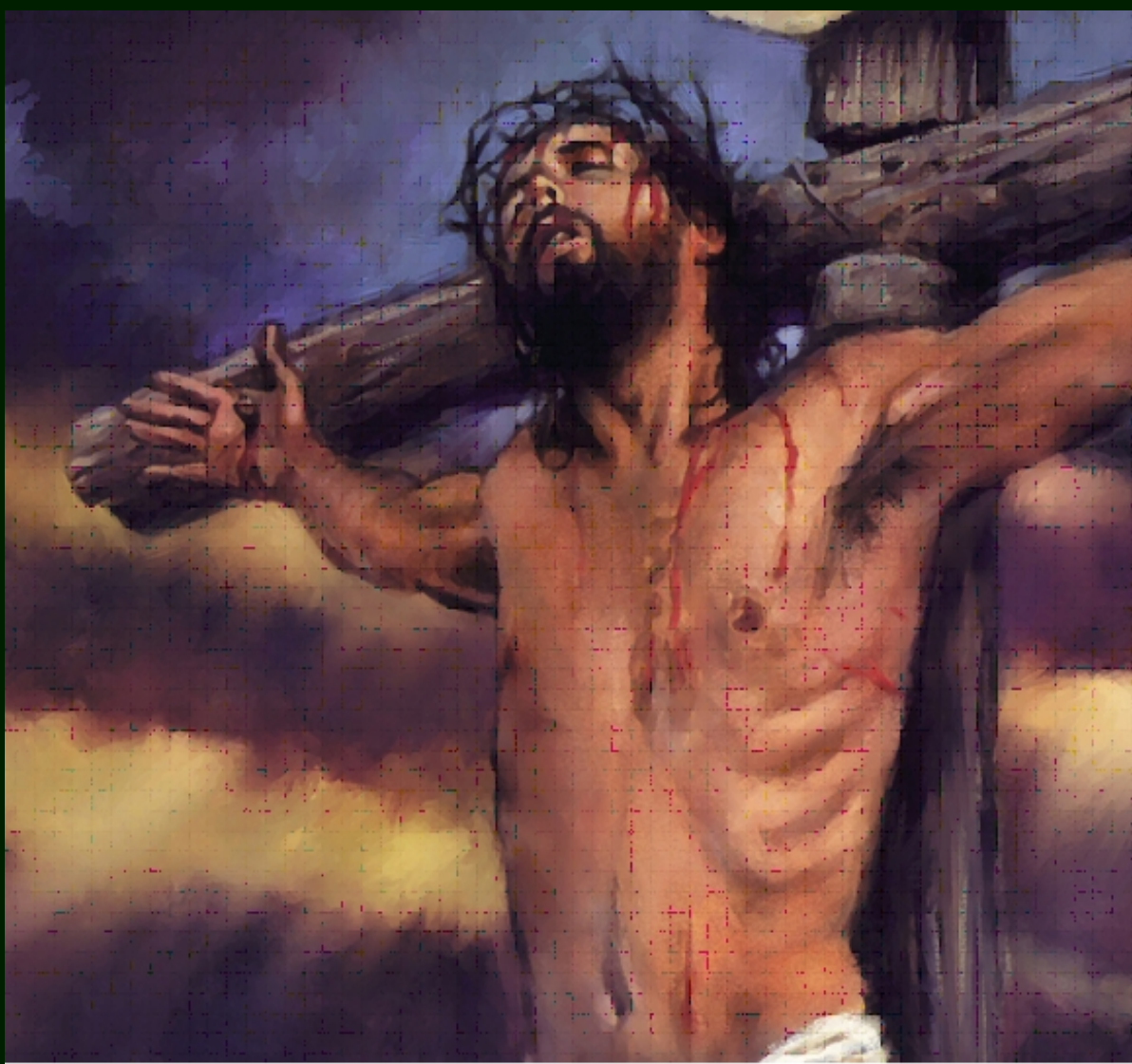

- **Suschematizo** meaning to fashion oneself according to, to conform oneself; mind and character to another's pattern.

# Definitions

---

- **Compliance:** This is doing something simply because someone told you to do so.

This is a kind of defomed Christianity.

It is Christianity void of Jesus.

Compliance leads to toxic faith.

Physically Philosophically Socially Financially Emotionally

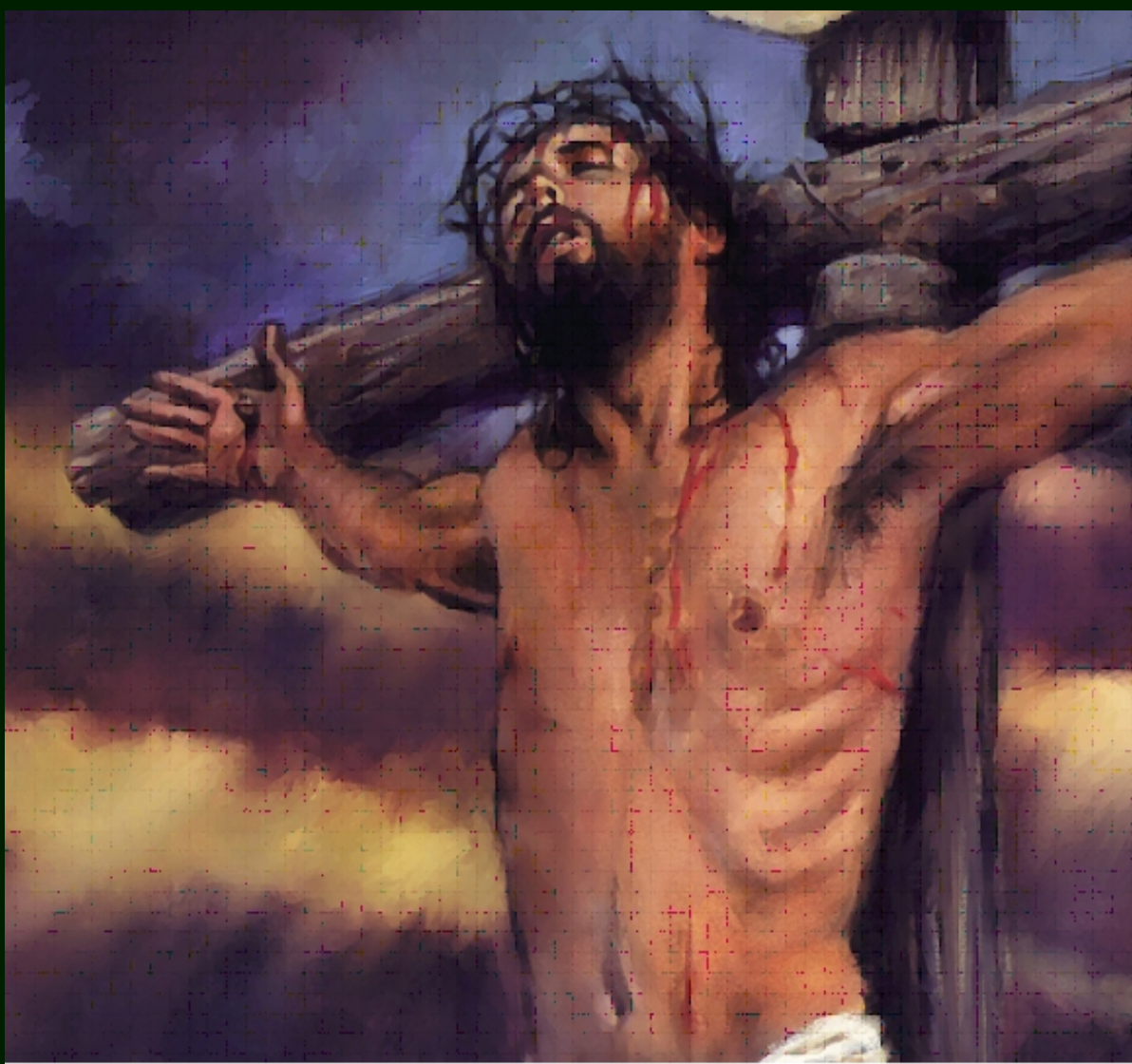
True revival means that you have been totally **reformed** (renewed in Jesus). Thus your mind is transformed (willingly obedient).
