The Sabbath will not be the seal
(our visible identity) in the last
days *(just before and after
probation closes)* if we have not
been first filled with the Holy
Spirit today.

When we live today as though the Sabbath is the primary seal of God we become spiritually deformed - legalistic and lukewarm (*Toxic faith*).

God's people will have the visible seal of the Sabbath in the last days only because they have been living under the power of the Holy Spirit.

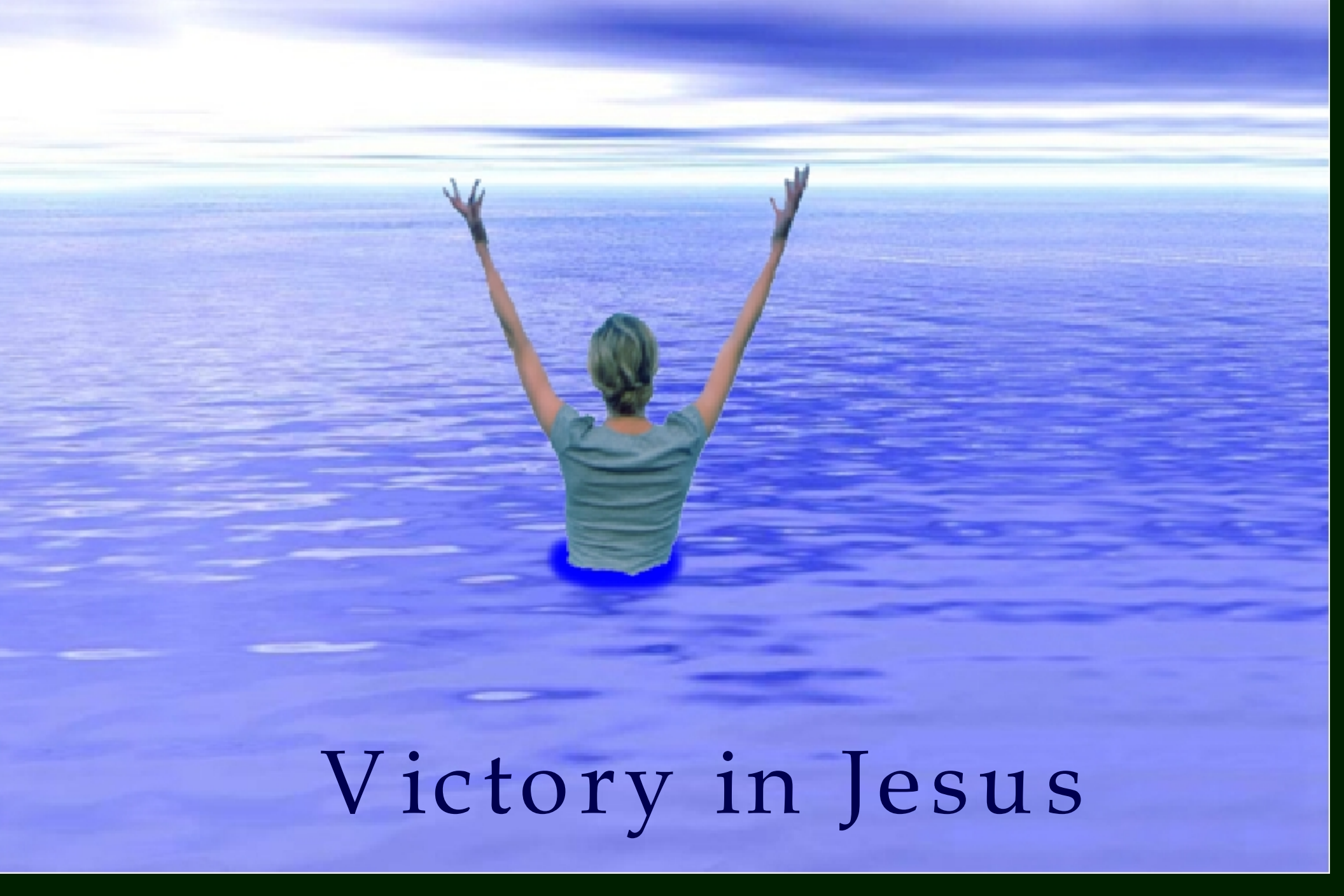

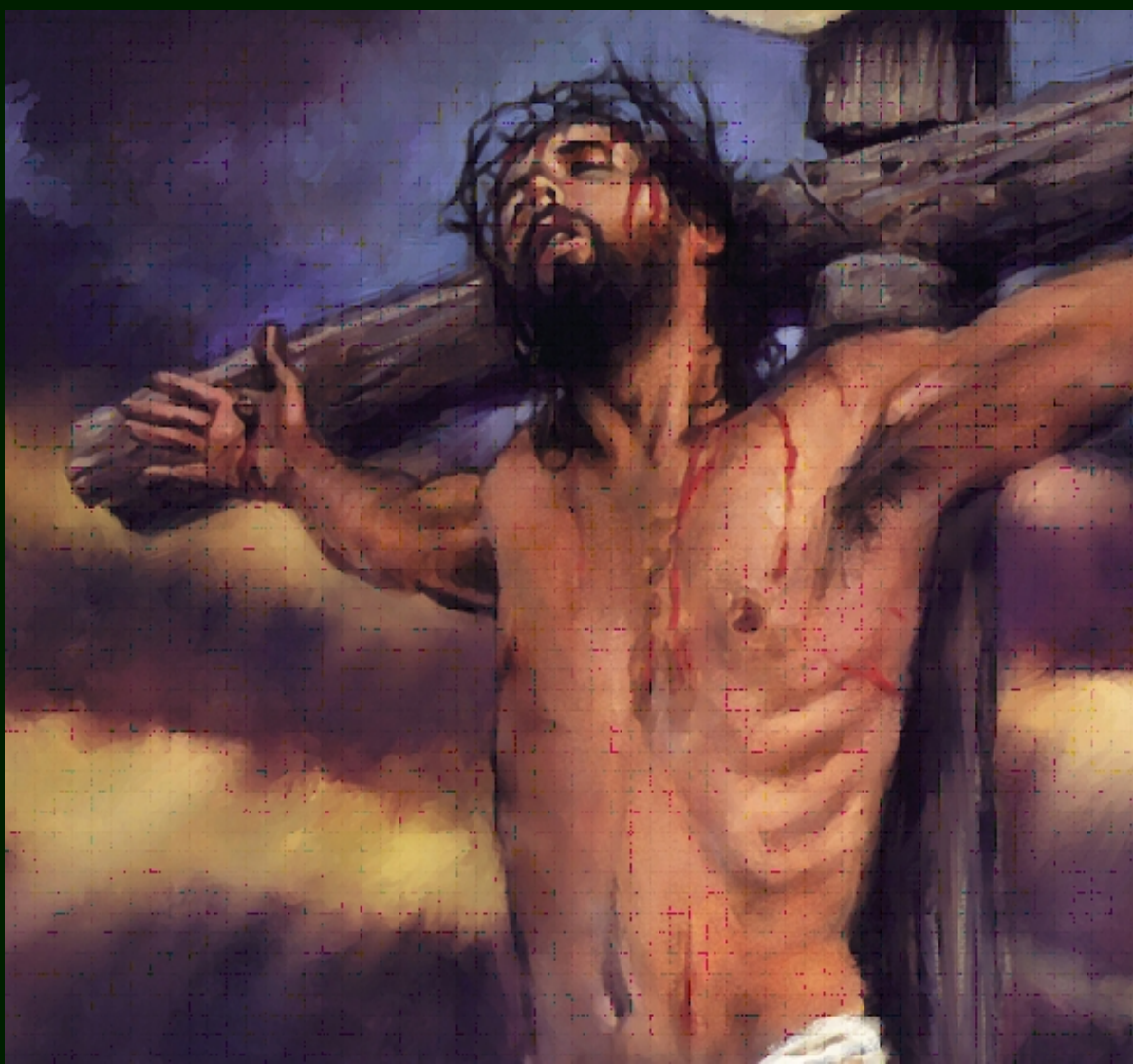
