Verse 33: Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for his own? Will God? No! He is the one who has given us right standing with himself.

Verse 34: Who then will condemn us? Will Christ Jesus? No, for he is the one who died for us and was raised to life for us and is sitting at the place of highest honor next to God, pleading for us.
