Weekly Chores

This time table can be rotated each month to allow for each family member to participate in each chore over a period of time.

This is a sample time table of chores for a family of four school-aged children (Tom, Sally, George, Robert), and Mom and Dad. This time table assumes that each child has a separate bedroom and they share a bathroom and are responsible for cleaning.

Mom and Day have their own bedroom and bathroom of which they are responsible for cleaning.

Children are responsible for cleaning their own bedrooms, therefore, these are not assigned.

On a select day of the month or year Mom and Dad can have everyone join in doing all chores (Cleanup day).

Note carefully that chores on days of worship can be adjusted or omitted.
