




Heaven came down and glory filled my soul.



O what a wonderful, wonderful day -Day I will never forget; After I'd wandered in darkness away, Jesus my Saviour I met.




O what a tender, compassionate friend - He met the need of my heart; Shadows dispelling, With joy I am telling, He made all the darkness depart.


And it's because of that wonderful day when at the cross I believed; Riches eternal and blessings supernal from His precious hand I received.

- Reformation is when others can see Jesus in me



It is Christianity void of Jesus.


Compliance leads to toxic faith.

We praise Thee, O God! For the Son of Thy love, For Jesus Who died, And is now gone above.


