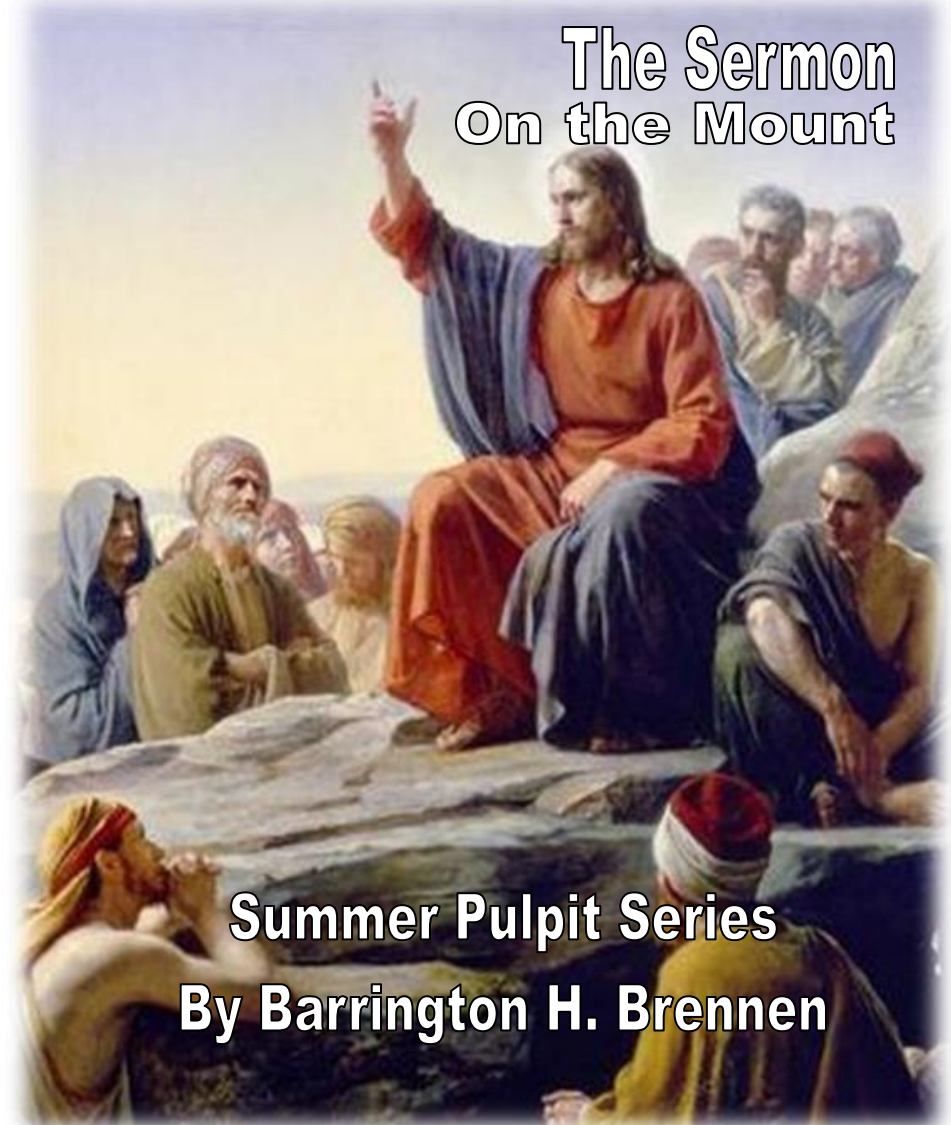

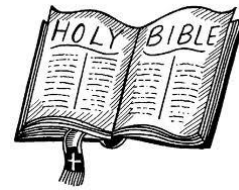

FOCUS ON EDUCATION: EVERYDAY PLEASANTRIES

Pleasantries are words that help us to be thoughtful, kind, respectful, caring and all the other good character traits that we want to instil in our children – words such as: “please,” “thank you,” “you’re welcome,” and “excuse me”. Say, **"Please"** and **"Thank you"** often. It shows respect and appreciation. If someone thanks you, then say, **"You're welcome"** for “you are welcome”. Do not interrupt grown-ups who are speaking with each other unless there is an emergency. They will notice you and respond when they are finished talking. If you do need to get somebody's attention right away, the phrase **"excuse me"** is the most polite way for you to enter the conversation.

When you have any doubt about doing something, ask permission first. It can save you from many hours of grief later.

Respect differences. When people do things differently from your family because of diversity in culture, race, or religion, learn to respect those

differences. *“And all thy children shall be taught of the LORD; and great shall be the peace of thy children”*. Isaiah 54:13 (KJV)
