Please note that the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, General Conference Session Management, the Alamodome, and the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center are not responsible for the safety of your family. Keep your children in your care at all times.

EXAMPLE OF CHURCH MANUAL DECISIONS TO BE MADE:

Usually the changes made are simple, to provide easy reading or remove ambiguity. There will be no fundamental changes to any Adventist belief. In all of the 28 beliefs there will be a word changed or removed or Bible texts added or removed to make it clearer to readers. For example on Fundamental Belief Six Belief-Creation, there will be clarity on our position on Creation. The language will be more directed to support our views of Creation. In Fundamental Belief Twenty-Three on Marriage and Family, the word "partners" will be replaced with "man and woman" to strengthen our views of marriage.

ORDINATION OF WOMEN TO THE GOSPEL MINISTRY: There are a few things that will happen at this time. There will be the acceptance of the paper on the "Theology and Practice of Ministerial Ordination"

After presentations are made the delegates will be asked to vote on the following regarding women ordination to the gospel ministry. Here is the question below:

WHEREAS, The unity for which Jesus prayed is vitally important to the witness of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, and;

WHEREAS, The Seventh-day Adventist Church seeks to engage every member in its worldwide mission to make disciples of Jesus Christ among people from every nation, culture and ethnicity, and;

WHEREAS, Various groups appointed by the General Conference and its divisions have carefully studied the Bible and Ellen G White writings with respect to the ordination of women and have not arrived at consensus as to whether ministerial ordination for women is unilaterally affirmed or denied, and;

WHEREAS, The Seventh-day Adventist Church affirms that "God has ordained that the 36 representatives of His Church from all parts of the earth, when assembled in a General Conference Session, shall have authority",

THEREFORE, The General Conference Executive Committee requests delegates in their sacred responsibility to God at the 2015 General Conference Session to respond to the following question:

After your prayerful study on ordination from the Bible, the writings of Ellen G White, and the reports of the study commissions, and; After your careful consideration of what is best for the Church and the fulfillment of its mission, Is it acceptable for division executive committees, as they may deem it appropriate in their territories, to make provision for the ordination of women to the gospel ministry? **Yes or No**

ELECTONIC VOTING: Note that all voting will done electronically at this GC Session. It is the first time it will be done this way.

- To amend the Church Manual, Chapter 7, Discipline, pages 61 and 62, 7 Reasons for Discipline
- To change Adventist Youth Society to Adventist Youth Ministries (AYM)
- To change the name of the Adventist Review department to Adventist Review Ministries
