



What a joy it is to be here today to worship and praise God in His sanctuary. Today is a special day in the Adventist Church. It is the time for the quarterly Communion Service. We welcome everone to participate. Adventists conduct and open communion where people of all faiths can join in. Today is a time for cleansing and renewal. We will wash

our feet as a sybmbol of rebaptism or cleaning. Adventists consider the feet washing ceremony as a minuture baptism. It is a time when one can "wash away" the past sins and move forward in faith. The eating of the unleaven bread and drinking of the unfermented grape juice is a reminder of the sacrifice of Jesus on our behalf. This is truly a time to celebrate.

GENERAL CONFERENCE SESSION 2015 July 2-11: Within three weeks 60th General Conference Session of the Seventh-day Adventist Church will begin in San Antonio, Texas, USA. At the sessions there is election of officers, policy changes, and reports given. Do you realized the General Conference Sessions in the beginning of our church were every year, then every two years. Now it is every five years. "The time between Sessions has lengthened over the years. Session was held every year until 1891. Session was then held every other year until 1905. Session then took a four-year break followed by another hiatus during World War I before meeting again in 1918. Afterward, Session was held every four years until the Great Depression -- Session was held in 1930, but then not again until 1936 and then in 1941. Since 1970, Session has been held every five years, as is mandated by the Adventist Church Constitution." The theme for GC 2015 is "Arise! Shine! Jesus is Coming!" The theme song is "We Have This Hope." This theme song has been used as a GC theme song since 1962.

DELEGATES: There will be 2566 delegates from around the world. There are 1559 regular delegates (those who are chosen their fields) and 1007 delegates-at-large (those who are delegates because of their positions). Alexanderia Scott, our member, is one of the offical delegates from our Conference to the session. Others are Pastor Scavella, Joseph, and Lewis There are 75,000 Adventist Churches around the world and 18 million Adventists.
