Elisa Rahming was born to Edmund and Emily Rahming in Nassau, Bahamas, and is the last of three children. Her siblings and their families: sister, Edlyn married to Darrington with son, Shiloh, and brother, Edmund Jr. married to Devincia with son, Seth, are all very dear to her. Elisa's first memories are of Knoxville, Tennessee, where she and her family lived for five years while her parents were furthering their education at the University of Tennessee, Knoxville. When they moved back to the Bahamas, she had the pleasure of growing up five minutes away from the beach. Unbeknown to her at the time, this sparked a deep love of the beach which continues to this day.

She learned about Jesus and His love for her in her early years at home, in Sabbath School at Hillview Seventh-day Adventist Church, and school at Bahamas Academy of Seventh-day Adventist.
